## Punctuality—Lateness

**!** Being stood on the gate every day, I am becoming increasingly aware of the number of children who are arriving at school late **every day**.

Please can I remind all parents that children in **Y1 to Y6** should be in school between **8.30am and 8.45am**. The doors will open at **8.40am**. If your child is arriving after 8.45am then they are late. If you see me standing at the top gate in the morning and your child is in Y1-Y6 then your child will be late.

**Reception and Nursery start between 8.45am and 9am.**

Please make sure your child is in school on time. When your child arrives late, it disrupts the taking of the register in class (a legal document) and disrupts the office who have to deal with taking late lunch orders and escorting children to class.

Obviously there are some days when circumstances mean your child may be late but for some children this is becoming an everyday occurrence and this is not acceptable. Please help us create a calm start to every day.
