Reading

We encourage children to read every night in KS1 and for you to record this in your child's planner.

Spelling - Key Word Cards

These words are the common exception words for Year 1 and 2. It is important that your child is confident in spelling these before moving up to KS2. Practise these with your child at home and when they are secure with all words on the card, we will test them in school.

Spellings - Twinkl App

These are the weekly spellings that we will learn in class. There will be no test, but it is important that the children do the activities with these words on the app. The children have their Twinkl Login details in their reading planner.

Doodle Maths

Encourage your child to complete a daily doodle. There will be an assignment set each week which will be linked to the learning completed in class. Passwords for Doodle are in the reading planner.


Numeracy

Art and DT
Style in Art

Children will learn that different artists create different styles of art.

They will look at some pointillist paintings and try out this technique. They will also look at some works by Vincent Van Gogh and try painting in his style.

Sculpture Art

Children will learn about sculpture as a form of art. They will look at Degas' little dancer and try shape clay to make their own sculptures

Food Technology


The children will begin to learn safe cutting techniques to peel and slice some fruit. They will design and make a fruit product.



RE

Themes that will be covered this term are Symbols and actions. They will learn about symbols in everyday life and within different religions, and discuss the actions and practices that are important to people of faith.

Through this, they will develop understanding, respect and curiosity about different beliefs.




Science

The children will learn to identify different plants including trees that they may see in their local area.

They will distinguish between wild and garden plants and will name key parts of plants including trees.

They will observe and describe seasonal changes

They will plant seeds and observe and describe the growth of plants.



Geography

The children will learn about some of the main habitats around the world such as arctic areas, deserts, grasslands, the ocean and rainforests. They will find out how these

different habitats support a range of plants and animals.



Computing

Computing this term will consist of the children creating an e-book which will include text, images and sounds. As well as this they will also be creating simple instructions through coding.



History

This term the children will be learning about some different famous explorers.

In this topic, they will:

Know what an explorer is and what they do. Be able to plot different explorers on a timeline and study the achievements of different explorers and discuss why these are important.



Music with Ms Andrews

In music the children will continue building a knowledge of pitch, rhythm and tempo. As well as continuing to sing songs from memory.

The children will also be getting prepared for their music recital!



PSHE with Mrs Bedford

The children will begin to learn how to keep themselves safe and they will learn techniques that they may be able to use to calm themselves if they are experiencing difficult, strong emotions.
